Our Missions focus for February is Aaron and Rachel Halbert with Mission to the World (MTW) in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Please see their message and prayer requests below.

I am currently preaching through the book of Genesis in the mornings and through Acts in the evenings. We continue to have good attendance at both services, 135 people in the morning and 80 at night. We are currently working towards adding some bathrooms onto the building to accommodate the number of people attending. Please pray for that process and for a timely finish to the project.

We are very grateful for the Lord's hearing our prayer for more laborers. One couple moved here in August, and another couple is arriving soon. We are also recruiting a couple from Jackson that will be coming down in March for a vision trip. Please pray for that process as well.

Pray for me as I seek to train officers for the church. We had 6 men nominated for office and we are extremely grateful to the Lord for the provision of these men. Pray for the process of training and for deep understanding for what it means to hold the office of elder or deacon in the church. Pray for unity as well.

Pray for Rachel and the kids as they continue to do homeschool together. Pray that they would all find great joy in learning and be patient one with another. Pray for their growth in love and affection for the Lord Jesus as they learn about His creation together.

Pray for wisdom for future church planting efforts. Clarity as we look to plant multiple churches around the city.
